**Narrative**

Recently, the mother "walked into the middle of a fight" while holding Jordan. As a result, Jordan sustained an injury to his lip. The mother has lost custody of her children in the past due to fighting. At the time of this incident, the father was fighting a woman, because he had physically attacked the woman's child. The mother and the father are both known to be violent and dangerous people. The father has a gun in the home.

There are concerns for environmental hazards. The home is never clean. The father sells cocaine and marijuana from the home. The mother and the father use marijuana and cocaine "all of the time" while inside of the home.

**Field Narrative**

CPI added verified allegations of failure to protect in regard to Jordan Belliveau Jr. with the mother Charisse Stinson and father Jordan Belliveau as the caregivers responsible. CPI added verified allegations for inadequate supervision in regard to child Jordan Belliveau Jr. with the father as the caregiver responsible.

 What surrounding circumstances accompany the alleged maltreatment, precipitating events, history?**

Case was staffed at a 2nd Tier level for the "other", streamline investigation track. CPI launched the FFA in error. An FFA is not needed at this time due to all members of the investigation being open to case management services. They are all participants on an ongoing FFA.

Summary of Investigation:

At this time impending danger is not being identified. There was an incident on 6/18/17 at Burger King in which the mother and father of victim child Jordan Belliveau Jr. were involved in a physical fight with multiple other parties. There are concerns for gang activity as Clearwater Police Department reported that there has been ongoing gang related violence between the Belliveau and Ellis family. During the fight child Jordan Belliveau Jr. was hit in the face by Danielle Ellis and sustained an injury to his upper lip. The mother explained that she was trying to pull the father out of the fight when the child was hit in the face. She did not seem to recognize that being near the fight with the child in her arms put the child in an unsafe situation.

Victim child Jordan Belliveau Jr. was seen by EMS while on scene due to being hit in the face. He was alert, calm, and did not appear to be in any distress. They observed no external bleeding and minimal swelling to his lip. The mother signed a refusal for the child. The child was seen by CPT on 6/20/17 and there were verified findings for physical abuse and parental neglect. Pinellas County Sheriff's investigated the concerns for physical injury and drug sales from the home alongside CPI. PCSO report was closed solved non-criminal.

The victim child Jordan Belliveau Jr. is currently in foster care and is a safe environment. The mother had unsupervised visits at the time of the incident, but now the mother and father's visits are supervised at a facility. The mother has recently expressed interest in signing surrenders, but this needs to be explored further by case management.

It was alleged that the father sells cocaine and marijuana from the home and the mother and father both use marijuana and cocaine all of the time while inside of the home at the Largo address. The composition of this household, as reported, includes Jessica Belliveau, Charisse Stinson, and Jessica's children Jaiden Belliveau and Javone Dickerson. All parties deny that Jordan lives at the home, although he showed up to the home with his mother Jessica Belliveau. Concerns for Jordan Belliveau being in the home have been expressed to case management. Jordan was court-ordered out of the home along with Jessica's other adult children in the previous investigation. [REDACTED]

PCSO investigated the concerns for physical injury and drug sales from the home alongside CPI. PCSO Report SO17-197160 was closed solved non-criminal.

The victim child Jordan Belliveau Jr. is currently in foster care and is a safe environment. The mother had unsupervised visits at the time of the incident, but now the mother and father's visits are supervised at a facility. The mother has recently expressed interest in signing surrenders, but this needs to be explored further by case management.

The allegations state that the father sells cocaine and marijuana from the home and the mother and father both use marijuana and cocaine all of the time while inside of the home. The home address on the report was listed as 1763 S MARTIN LUTHER KING AVE, APT A, LARGO, FL. The composition of this household, as reported, includes Jessica Belliveau, Charisse Stinson, and [REDACTED]. All parties deny that Jordan lives at the home, although he showed up to the home with his mother Jessica Belliveau. Concerns for Jordan Belliveau being in the home have been expressed to case management. Jordan was court-ordered out of the home along with Jessica's other adult children in the previous investigation. A conversation will be had with mother Jessica Belliveau. [REDACTED]
